Nature Weeks is a week-long program. Days start at 9 a.m. and end at 3 p.m. The fee per week is \$225; the fee for each additional sibling is \$210 per child. For those with a Frosty Drew family membership, the fee is \$200 per week per child. The fee includes a t-shirt that your child will create. Financial aid is available. Extended care is available from 8 to 9 a.m. and from 3 to 5 p.m. at \$10 per hour per child.

Please make your check payable to the *Frosty Drew Memorial Fund* and mail it to P. O. Box 160, Charlestown, RI 02813. You may also pay online at <http://frostydrew.org>.

Registration is on a first-come, first-served basis. In order for your application to be considered, payment must be received with your application. You will be notified of your child's acceptance by email or mail. If your child has signed up for the week of July 3–July 7 and cannot attend on July 4, the fee for that day will be refunded.

If you need to cancel your child's Nature Week, please let the Nature Weeks Director know as soon as possible. Note, no refund will be given if a child is withdrawn within one week of the start of his or her Nature Week unless the space can be filled.
